The **Right to Information (RTI)** is a **fundamental legal right of citizens** that allows them to **seek, receive, and inspect information** held by **public authorities**. In India, this right is governed by the **Right to Information Act, 2005**, which came into force on **12 October 2005**. The **Right to Information (RTI)** is very useful in **educational institutions** which comes under Section 4(1)(b) and Section 2(h) especially universities and colleges. RTI is useful in educational institutions as it promotes transparency, accountability, and fairness in admissions, fees, examinations, and administration.

The **University Grants Commission (UGC)** plays a supervisory and regulatory role in ensuring transparency, accountability, and effective implementation of the RTI Act in colleges and universities.
